

BLADE INFORMATION for your SENSATION POWER MOWER

The cutting blades for all SENSATION MOWERS are specifically designed to give the maximum efficiency for the mower they are mounted on. Mounting the wrong blade on your mower will decrease the efficiency, and in some cases will cause damage to the mower itself. For the sake of safety, as well as efficient operation, the blade should never be mounted so that its lowest part is below the lowest portion of the guards or baffles. However, the maximum possible space should be allowed between the blade and the underside of the mower.

Blade research and development is a continuous process at SENSATION. If in ordering a replacement blade for your machine, you receive a blade that is a little heavier, or a little lighter, or contains a different type of steel, or is a little narrower or wider, it is because this continual testing has shown it to be better in some respects than the blade the machine was originally equipped with. We always send the latest type blade in filling blade orders.

It is IMPERATIVE that you give complete information when ordering new blades - the <u>Model Number</u> and the <u>Serial Number</u> of your unit as shown on the <u>SENSATION</u> nameplate - as well as length and hole size, amount of drop, if any, of the blade is desired. Refer to Blade Replacement Data sheet and order by part number if possible.

On Blade Replacement Data sheet, the last two columns show parts numbers for two types of blades --- POWER and AIR-LIFT.

"AIR-LIFT" blade is recommended where the smoothest job of mowing is desired and where the lawn is cut at regular intervals. The Air-Lift built into these blades, when used on our mower, provides a vertical air current to cut the grass with least possible injury and to discharge clippings through the openings provided. The Air-Lift type of blade should not generally be used for rough cutting. This blade can be used for any mulching job and for leaf grinding. For information on Sensation's LEAF GRINDING EQUIPMENT, refer to the ACCESSORIES sheet.

"POWER" blade is a straight, flat blade used for rough cutting or weed cutting or where additional power and not particular smoothness is required. These formerly were called Standard blades.

Please note - We do not make the Power blade for any of the Mow-Blo, Electra-Blo, and Satellite machines as the one blade used gives best performance and desired results.
